

REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3115: Appropriation; Alcorn State-Agricultural Programs.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General  
7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the  
8 Alcorn State University Agricultural Programs for the fiscal year beginning  
9 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002 .....\$ 4,739,758.00.

10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
11 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special source  
12 funds which are collected by or otherwise become available, for the support  
13 and maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Programs for  
14 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002\$ 972,207.00.

15 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Twenty-two  
16 Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (\$22,207.00) shall be derived from  
17 funds in the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections  
18 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

19 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
20 Section 2, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be derived  
21 from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Senate Bill No. 2680, Regular  
22 Session of 2001.

23 SECTION 5. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall  
24 be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being  
25 used for salaries which are withdrawn and no longer available.

26 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's  
27 budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be submitted to the Joint  
28 Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to  
29 the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget

30 request process.

31           SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the  
32 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the  
33 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the  
34 State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
35 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the  
36 manner provided by law.

37           SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after  
38 July 1, 2001.
