## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3120: Appropriation; Emergency Management Agency.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State
- 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
- 10 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management
- 11 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et
- 12 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning
- 13 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 752,184.00.
- 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 15 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special

18	funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the	
19	support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year

46	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of		
47	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to		
48	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal		
49	Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002		
50	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions		
51	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the		
52	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the		
53	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall		
54	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all		
55	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this		
56	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure		
57	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual		
58	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal		
59	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,

- 72 this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

- 79 the request of a local public emergency management organization
- 80 in an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply
- 81 equipment to rural water associations to enable their continued

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82 operation when the local emergency management organization
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- 83 determines that such private entities provide services essential
- 84 to the welfare of the community.
- 85 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 86 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall
- 87 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors,
- 88 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in
- 89 disaster management.
- 90 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 91 necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 92 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency
- 93 Management Agency to be used to establish a special reserve fund
- 94 in the State Treasury for Disaster Relief, for the fiscal year
- 95 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....
- 96 .....\$ 65,726.00.
- 97 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 98 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 99 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund
- 100 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain
- 101 administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the
- 102 Disaster Relief Program, for the fiscal year beginning
- 103 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 5,606,000.00.
