REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3126: Appropriation; Veterans Affairs Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 5 б General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans 8 Affairs Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 2,955,095.00. 9 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 12 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs

Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 13 14 otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance 15 of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and 16 ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 20,786,211.00. 17 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health 18 19 Care Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Veterans 20 Affairs Board for the support of the Mississippi State Veterans 21 Homes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 22 June 30, 2002.....\$ 700,000.00. 23 SECTION 4. 47 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 48 49 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 51 52 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 53 54 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 55 56 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 57 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 58 59 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 60 61 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 62 63 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 64 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions 65 which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 66 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 67 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of

this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 5. Of Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds 5. In the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

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\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran surviving 5 spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse was a resident of a 6 state veterans home at the time of the veteran's death and who, subsequent 7 to the veteran's death, meets the indigent/low-income criteria established by 8 the State Veterans Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the 9 intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of 10 indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such period, 11 prior to the effective date of this act, that a current surviving spouse may 12 have met the criteria. This section and its provisions shall be known and 13 cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997." 14

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive 15 Director of the Veterans Affairs Board may authorize increases in major 16 objects of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed five percent (5%) of 17 the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided that 18 other major objects of expenditure are decreased by the corresponding 19 dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase 20 the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 21 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 22 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the 23 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the 24 State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 25 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the 26 manner provided by law. 27

28 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after 29 July 1, 2001.
