AMEND by striking Section 1 of the bill in its entirety and
 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 "SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 4 Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to enter into one or 5 more lease agreements with one or more public or private entities 6 in regard to the granting of a property interest to such public or 7 private entities in all or any part of the real property located in Hinds County, Mississippi, generally known as the "Mississippi 8 9 Veterans Memorial Stadium Property, " being any property under the 10 jurisdiction of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 11 Commission and any other state-owned property located in the area 12 bounded on the North by Taylor Street, on the West by North West 13 Street, on the South by Woodrow Wilson Avenue and on the East by North State Street used as part of or in connection with 14 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium, for the purpose of the 15 construction of improvements thereon. 16

17 (2) Any lease authorized in this section may be for such
18 consideration as determined appropriate by the Mississippi
19 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and may be for a primary term
20 not to exceed twenty-five (25) years and may be renewed for a term

21 not to exceed twenty-five (25) years.

22 (3) In and for the consideration to be provided under any 23 lease, the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to, on such terms and conditions 24 25 determined to be appropriate by the Mississippi Veterans Memorial 26 Stadium Commission: (a) enter into agreements with any such 27 lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not exceeding 28 29 the term of such lease (including renewals and extensions) 30 permitting use of any property referred to in subsection (1) of 31 this section for parking, access and other uses in connection with 32 events in facilities constructed on property leased from the 33 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission; (b) grant, as 34 part of and for the term of any lease, to any lessee or lessees 35 (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), one or more easements with respect to all or any part of the property referred 36 37 to in subsection (1) of this section for vehicle and pedestrian ingress and egress, for vehicle parking and for such other 38 purposes necessary and appropriate for the construction, operation 39 40 and use of the improvements; (c) enter into agreements with any such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 41 42 lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not 43 exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 44 extensions), permitting use by such lessee or lessees (or any 45 designee of any such lessee or lessees) of Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium for events; (d) enter into agreements with any 46 such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 47 lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not 48 49 exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 50 extensions), pursuant to which the state shall be obligated to

51 purchase improvements constructed on such property upon terms and 52 for a purchase price, not to exceed Twelve Million Dollars 53 (\$12,000,000.00), as set forth in or determined in accordance with 54 such agreement; and/or (e) enter into such other agreements with 55 any such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 56 lessees) or any other public or private entities, which agreements 57 may extend over any period of time not exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and extensions), relating to any such 58 59 lease and any improvements to be constructed on property leased 60 from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission as the 61 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall determine 62 to be appropriate. However, the State of Mississippi shall not be 63 obligated to purchase any improvements constructed on property 64 leased under this section unless the construction of all such 65 improvements on the property is complete. The Department of 66 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 67 Grounds and Real Property Management shall make the determination 68 regarding whether the construction of the improvements is 69 complete.

70 Any public body shall be authorized to enter into: (a) (4) 71 agreements (which may extend over any period of time) with the 72 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, any public body, 73 any party leasing property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial 74 Stadium Commission (or any designee or designees of any such 75 lessee), and/or any other party to provide or contribute funds in 76 connection with the construction, financing and/or operation of 77 any improvements constructed on property leased from the 78 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, and any such 79 agreement or agreements and the obligations of any public body 80 thereunder shall not be included in computing amounts subject to

81 any debt limitations applicable to any such public body; and/or 82 (b) agreements (which may extend over any period of time) to lease 83 property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and to provide or contribute funds in connection with the 84 85 construction, financing and/or operation of any improvements constructed on such property and to lease or sublease any such 86 87 property or improvements to public or private entities, and any 88 such agreement or agreements shall not be included in computing 89 amounts subject to any debt limitations applicable to any such 90 public body.

91 (5) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in 92 its discretion, is authorized to enter into all other agreements 93 as may be necessary or appropriate in connection with any 94 financing by any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such 95 lessee or lessees) of any improvements to be constructed on 96 property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 97 Commission.

98 (6) The provisions of any statutes establishing a role for 99 the Department of Finance and Administration and the State Bond 100 Commission in financing, construction and improvement of buildings 101 on the Veterans Memorial Stadium property shall not apply to the 102 financing, refinancing, construction, repair or improvement of any 103 improvements on any property leased pursuant to this act.

104 (7) Before entering into any lease or other agreement with 105 any private entity under this section, the Mississippi Veterans 106 Memorial Stadium Commission shall require such entity to enter 107 into a binding commitment providing that if the private entity 108 fails to complete the construction of all improvements commenced 109 by the entity on property leased under this section, such entity 110 shall reimburse the State of Mississippi for costs incurred by the 111 state relating to the improvements. The Department of Finance and 112 Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and 113 Real Property Management shall make the determination regarding 114 whether the construction of the improvements is complete.

115 (8) Any lease or other agreement entered into by the 116 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this 117 section shall not be valid unless approved by the Department of 118 Finance and Administration and the Attorney General.

(9) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission may not enter into any lease or other agreement under this section after October 1, 2001."
