21	(a) Educational consultation and collaboration with

- 24 (i) Follow-up counseling services.
- 25 (3) The State Department of Education may adopt rules and
- 26 regulations regarding the activities of the school guidance
- 27 counselors which are not inconsistent with this section.
- 28 (4) Nothing in this section may be construed to abrogate or
- 29 affect in any manner the supervisory authority of the school
- 30 principal over the school guidance counselor.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2001.
