Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 SECTION 1. Section 35-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 35-1-3. The State Veterans Affairs Board shall appoint, to
- 10 serve at the will and pleasure of the board, and who will be
- 11 subject to a biennial personnel performance review every two (2)
- 12 years, an executive director, (who shall also serve as Executive
- 13 Secretary of the State Veterans Affairs Board), a deputy director,
- 14 individuals to manage each of the agency's major functional areas
- 15 and individuals to manage each of the state veterans homes. The
- 16 executive director and deputy director shall be honorably
- 17 discharged or honorably released veterans of the Armed Forces of
- 18 the United States. The board may establish additional minimum
- 19 qualifications for agency positions.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2001.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 35-1-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD SHALL APPOINT
- 3 INDIVIDUALS TO MANAGE EACH OF THE AGENCY'S MAJOR FUNCTIONAL AREAS
- 4 AND INDIVIDUALS TO MANAGE EACH OF THE STATE VETERANS HOMES; AND
- 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
