AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2851

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

7 SECTION 1. Any person who takes or possesses a paddlefish in
8 violation of law or any rule or regulation of the Mississippi
9 Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or who commits waste
10 by discarding any parts of such fish into the waters of this
11 state, is guilty of a Class I violation and is punishable as
12 provided in Section 49-7-141.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effective and be in force
14 from and after July 1, 2001.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES A LAW
2 OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION OF THE MISSISSIPPI COMMISSION ON
3 WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS ESTABLISHED FOR THE PROTECTION OF
4 PADDLEFISH OR WHO COMMITS WASTE BY DISCARDING PADDLEFISH INTO THE
5 WATERS OF THIS STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
