Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Any person who takes or possesses a paddlefish in 8 violation of law or any rule or regulation of the Mississippi 9 Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or who commits waste 10 by discarding any parts of such fish into the waters of this 11 state, is guilty of a Class I violation and is punishable as 12 provided in Section 49-7-141.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effective and be in force 14 from and after July 1, 2001.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES A LAW 2 OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION OF THE MISSISSIPPI COMMISSION ON 3 WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS ESTABLISHED FOR THE PROTECTION OF 4 PADDLEFISH OR WHO COMMITS WASTE BY DISCARDING PADDLEFISH INTO THE 5 WATERS OF THIS STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
