Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

L4	SECTION 1. The State Department of Finance and
L5	Administration shall establish policies that allow the payment of

L8	electronic payment in the discretion of the department. Any fees
L9	or charges associated with the use of such electronic payments

22	the user will pay the full cost of using the electronic payment.
23	SECTION 2. The board of supervisors of any county and the
24	governing authorities of any municipality may allow the payment of
25	various taxes, fees and other accounts receivable to the county or
26	municipality by credit cards, charge cards, debit cards and other
27	forms of electronic payment, in accordance with policies
28	established by the State Auditor. Any fees or charges associated
29	with the use of such electronic payments shall be assessed to the
30	user of the electronic payment as an additional charge for
