102 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 103 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 104 and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive 105 license tag in recognition of his support for the Mississippi 106 107 Veterans Monument. The distinctive license tags so issued shall 108 be of such color and design as may be determined finally by the 109 State Tax Commission based upon three (3) recommendations 110 presented to the State Tax Commission by the Mississippi Veterans 111 Monument Commission, and ranked in order of preference by the 112 Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission.

The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax
