Based on data provided by the 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 50 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

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MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

- 52 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 53 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
- 55 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
- 56 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
- 57 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
- 58 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services"
- 59 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 61 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 62 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 66 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 67 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 68 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 69 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 70 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be
- 71 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a
- 72 nonprofit organization.
- 73 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 77 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 78 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 79 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after July 1, 2001.
