AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 3100

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8 defraying the administrative expenses of the State Board for
9 Community and Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning
10 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 7,085,903.00.

11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13 Treasury to the credit of the State Board for Community and Junior
14 Colleges, for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses
15 of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the
16 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....
17 \$ 12,278,770.00.

18 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
20 Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School and
21 College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the expenses

22 incurred in the regulation and administration of the Mississippi
23 Proprietary School and College Registration Law and the associated
24 expenses of the State Board of Community and Junior Colleges for
25 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
26 \$ 60,000.00.

27 SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
28 of Sections 1, 2 and 3, the following positions are authorized:

34 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
35 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

36 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
37 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
38 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
39 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

40 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
41 budget requests of the administrative expenses of the State Board
42 for Community and Junior Colleges for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be
43 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
44 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
45 provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.

46 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Five
47 Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) shall be expended from the Work
48 Force Carryover Fund as created by House Bill No. 1271, Regular
49 Session of 1995.

50 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
51 funds in the amount of Eleven Million Thirty-one Thousand Ninety-

four Dollars (\$11,031,094.00) are appropriated for the Workforce Education Program and Industrial Training. No funding obligation or commitment shall be made on behalf of the state for industrial training beyond the level of funding made available in this section. All industrial training program commitments made in Fiscal Year 2002 and future fiscal years shall be based only upon funds available in this section and any proposed commitments shall be approved by the Executive Director of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, or the Executive Director's designee prior to such commitment being finalized. Industrial training program commitments shall be made and based only upon training services provided and not for a specific funding amount. Any expenditures of funds authorized in this section are limited to obligations made July 1, 2001, or after, and shall not be expended for obligations made prior to this date.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be derived from Community College Network fees for the purpose of defraying the costs of the Community College Network and the administrative expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
