17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 25 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 26 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 27 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 28 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 36 37 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 38 39 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 40 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 41 42 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 43 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 44 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

45 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 46 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

47 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 48 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 49 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 50 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 51 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 52 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 53 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 54 the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating 55 the state welcome centers.

56 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and 57 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 58 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,

59 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United 60 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may 61 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the 62 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not 63 64 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved, 65 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise 66 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and 67 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

68 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 69 Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to 70 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 71 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 72 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 73 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2001. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be 81 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 82 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 83 provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the amount of Five Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$5,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2002. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

91 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
92 amount of One Million Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars
93 (\$1,067,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
94 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
95 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2002.
96 The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be
97 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

98 SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 99 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 100 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 101 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 102 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 103 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 104 performance measures provided below:

In addition to all other sums herein 162 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 163 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 164 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 165 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for Mississippi Technology Alliance, Incorporated, for the fiscal year 166 167 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 168\$ 1,000,000.00.

169 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 170 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for 171 support of Mississippi Technology Alliance, Incorporated, to 172 strengthen the business environment in Mississippi to spur the 173 creation and growth of technology-based industries, thus creating 174 many more high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive 175 Mississippi economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held 176 separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the 177 Mississippi Development Authority.

In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds for Mississippi Technology Alliance, Incorporated, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 150,000.00,

In addition to all other sums herein 186 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 187 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 188 189 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to 190 support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce 191 Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 192 June 30, 2002.....\$ 1,500,000.00.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 204 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 205 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 206 207 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 208 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 209 SECTION 18.
