50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 51 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the

52 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the

53 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall

54 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 55 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 56 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 57 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 58 59 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 60 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 61 62 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 63 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 64 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 65 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

67 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

73 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon 75 the request of a local public emergency management organization in 76 an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to 77 rural water associations to enable their continued operation when 78 the local emergency management organization determines that such 79 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the 80 community.

81 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 82 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall 83 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors,

84 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in 85 disaster management.

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 108 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 109 General Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Emergency 110 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 111 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 112 Hazard Mitigation Program, for the fiscal year beginning 113 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 100,000.00

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 115 116 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 117 372T for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 118 and the federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the April/May 1991 Flood, for the fiscal year 119 120 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 121\$ 200,000.00. 122 SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 154 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 155 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 156 Nos. 3724 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain 157 administrative expenses and federal share of the cost of the 158 Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant 159 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year 160 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 19,971,852.00. 161 SECTION 16. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 162 163 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 164 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 165 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 166 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 167 Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant 168 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year 169 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 1,500,000.00. 170 171 SECTION 17. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 172 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 173 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 174 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 175 and the federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program 176 resulting from the December 1998 Ice Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 177 178\$ 6,860,914.00. 179 SECTION 18. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 180 181 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 182 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 183 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 184 Public Assistance Program resulting from the December 1998 Ice Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 185 186 June 30, 2002.....\$ 400,000.00. 187 SECTION 19. The funds appropriated in Section 6 shall be 188 expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and 189 43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of

190 matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the 191 state.

SECTION 20. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by 192 this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be 193 194 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General 195 Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon 196 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 197 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 198 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 21. This act shall take effect and be in force from 199 200 and after July 1, 2001.
