41	With the funds	herein appropriated, it	is the	intention of

42 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 45 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 46 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 47 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 48 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

51 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 54 55 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 56 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 57 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 58 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 60 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 61 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 69 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 70 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

71 (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to 72 indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran 73 surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse 74 was a resident of a state veterans home at the time of the 75 veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's death, meets 76 the indigent/low-income criteria established by the State Veterans 77 Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of 78 79 indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such 80 period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current

81 surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its 82 provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance 83 Act of 1997."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated in this act shall be used to pay Pharmacy Technicians.

87 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 88 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 89 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 90 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 92 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 93 94 and after July 1, 2001.
