43 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 44 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 45 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 46 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 48 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 51 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 52 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 53 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 54 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 55 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 56 57 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 58 59 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 62 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, funds in the amount of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) shall be deposited into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund for the purpose assisting counties and municipalities in the replacement and rehabilitation of certain bridges located on local road systems in the counties and in municipalities within the counties.

5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 82 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
83 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
84 and after July 1, 2001.
