## House Bill NO. 451

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 51-35-305, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 51-35-305. (1) Flood and drainage control districts may now or hereafter be organized in this state under the provisions of 8 9 this article, in the manner hereinafter provided, whenever any 10 part of such district lies wholly or partially in or adjacent to any part of a municipality having a population of ten thousand 11 12 (10,000) or more inhabitants at the time of the filing of the petition to create such district. For the purposes of determining 13 14 population of any municipality, the last completed census prior to the filing of such petition shall be presumed to be the population 15 of such municipality at the time of the filing of such petition. 16 17 Each flood and drainage control district shall be an agency of the 18 state and a body politic and corporate, and may be composed of one 19 or more entire municipalities or a part or parts thereof, one or more entire counties or a part or parts thereof, or any 20 21 combination of counties and municipalities or a part or parts

- 22 thereof.
- 23 (2) This section shall stand repealed on July 2, 2001.
- 24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 51-35-305, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO EXTEND THE DATE OF REPEAL ONE DAY ON THE AUTHORITY TO ORGANIZE
- 3 FLOOD AND DRAINAGE CONTROL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
