Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-37-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-37-11. Every merchant or dealer or pawnbroker that sells
- 8 bowie-knives, dirk-knives, * * * brass or metallic knuckles * * *,
- 9 or <u>pistols</u> or <u>other firearms</u>, shall keep a record of all sales of
- 10 such weapons * * * sold, showing the description of the
- 11 weapons * * *, the name of the purchaser, and the description of
- 12 weapons * * * and date of sale; the record shall be maintained for
- 13 <u>five (5) years</u>. * * * The dealer who violates this section shall
- 14 be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not
- 15 less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars
- 16 (\$25.00).
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2001.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE THE REQUIREMENT FOR KEEPING RECORDS OF WEAPON AND
- 3 AMMUNITION SALES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
