Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. Section 17-23-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 7 17-23-1. (1) There is established a rural fire truck 8 acquisition assistance program to be administered by the 9 10 Department of Insurance for the purpose of assisting counties and 11 municipalities in the acquisition of fire trucks. (2) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to 12 be designated as the "Rural Fire Truck Fund." The Legislature may 13 appropriate * * * that amount necessary to fulfill the obligations 14 15 created under this section by the Department of Insurance, from the State General Fund to such special fund, which sum shall be 16 17 added to the remainder of the money transferred on July 1, 1995, and during the 1996 Regular Session to the Rural Fire Truck 18 Fund. * * * Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end 19 20 of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to 21 the credit of the fund. It is the intent of the Legislature that 2.2

- 26 (3) (a) A county that meets the requirements provided
- 27 herein may receive an amount not to exceed <u>Two Hundred Fifty</u>

- 39 Dollars (\$250,000.00).

- 41 truck under this section is eligible to submit applications for
- 42 <u>four (4)</u> fire trucks at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 43 (\$50,000.00) per truck or a total of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 44 <u>(\$200,000.00)</u>.
- 45 (iii) Any county that has received two (2) fire
- 46 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application for
- 47 <u>three (3)</u> fire trucks or a total of not more than <u>One Hundred</u>
- 48 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).
- 49 (iv) Any county that has received three (3) fire
- 50 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application for
- 51 <u>two (2)</u> fire trucks or a total of not more than <u>One Hundred</u>
- 52 <u>Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)</u>.

(v) Any county that has received four (4) fire

54 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application for

55 one (1) fire truck or a total of not more than Fifty Thousand

56 <u>Dollars (\$50,000.00)</u>.

57 (b) The board of supervisors of the county shall submit

58 its request for the receipt of monies to the Department of

59 Insurance. A committee composed of the Commissioner of Insurance,

60 the State Fire Coordinator, the Director of the Rating Bureau and

61 the Director of the State Fire Academy shall review the requests

62 by the boards of supervisors and shall determine whether the

county or municipality for which the board of supervisors has

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66 (c) To be eligible to receive monies under this

(i) A county or municipality must pledge to set

79 (ii) A municipality must provide adequate

80 documentation of its contract with the county that requires the

municipality to provide fire protection in rural areas. The term

82 "rural areas" means any area within the county located outside the

- 83 boundaries of an incorporated municipality or any incorporated
- 84 municipality with a population of two thousand five hundred
- 85 (2,500) or less.
- 86 (d) The Department of Insurance shall maintain an
- 87 accurate record of all monies distributed to counties and
- 88 municipalities and the number of fire trucks purchased and the
- 89 cost for each fire truck, such records to be kept separate from
- 90 other records of the Department of Insurance; notify counties and
- 91 municipalities of the rural fire truck acquisition assistance
- 92 program and the requirements for them to become eligible to
- 93 participate; adopt and promulgate such rules and regulations as
- 94 may be necessary and desirable to implement the provisions of this
- 95 chapter; and file with the Legislature * * * a report detailing
- 96 how monies made available under this chapter were distributed and
- 97 spent during the preceding portion of the fiscal year in each
- 98 county and municipality, the number of fire trucks purchased, the
- 99 counties and municipalities making such purchases and the cost of
- 100 each fire truck purchased.

- 102 and after July 1, 2001.
