Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 97-29-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 97-29-45. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or 8 persons: 9 (a) To make any comment, request, suggestion or 10 proposal over a telephone which is obscene, lewd or lascivious with intent to abuse, threaten or harass any party to a telephone 11 12 conversation; (b) To make a telephone call, with intent to terrify, 13 14 intimidate or harass, and threaten to inflict injury or physical harm to any person at the called number or to his property; 15 16 (c) To make a telephone call, whether or not conversation ensues, without disclosing his identity and with 17 intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any person at the 18 19 called number; 20 (d) To make or cause the telephone of another

repeatedly or continuously to ring, with intent to harass any

- 23 (e) To make repeated telephone calls, during which
- 24 conversation ensues, solely to harass any person at the called
- 25 number; or
- 26 (f) Knowingly to permit any telephone under his control
- 27 to be used for any purpose prohibited by this section.
- 28 (2) <u>Upon conviction of any person for the first offense of</u>
- 29 <u>violating subsection (1) of this section, such person shall be</u>
- 30 <u>fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned</u>
- 31 <u>in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, or both.</u>
- 32 (3) Upon conviction of any person for the second offense of
- 33 violating subsection (1) of this section, the offenses being
- 34 <u>committed within a period of five (5) years, such person shall be</u>
- 35 fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned
- in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or both.
- 37 (4) For any third or subsequent conviction of any person
- 38 violating subsection (1) of this section, the offenses being
- 39 <u>committed within a period of five (5) years, such person shall be</u>
- 40 guilty of a felony and fined not more than Two Thousand Dollars
- 41 (\$2,000.00) and/or imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not
- 42 more than two (2) years, or both.
- 43 (5) The provisions of this section do not apply to a person
- 44 or persons who make a telephone call that would be covered by the
- 45 provisions of the federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, 15
- 46 <u>USC Section 1692 et seq.</u>
- 47 (6) \* \* \* Any person violating this section may be
- 48 prosecuted in the county where the telephone call, conversation or
- 49 language originates in case such call, conversation or language
- 50 originates in the State of Mississippi. In case the call,
- 51 conversation or language originates outside of the State of

- 52 Mississippi then such person shall be prosecuted in the county to
- 53 which it is transmitted.
- 54 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 55 and after July 1, 2001.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE PENALTIES FOR THREATENING OR HARASSING PHONE CALLS; AND
- 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
