## House Bill NO. 1307

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 97-17-87, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 97-17-87. (1) Any person who shall be guilty of a willful or malicious trespass upon the real or personal property of 8 9 another, for which no other penalty is prescribed, shall, upon 10 conviction, be fined not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned not longer than six (6) months in the county jail, 11 12 or both. (2) (a) Any person who shall willfully trespass upon any 13 14 air operations area or sterile area of an airport serving the general public shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon 15 16 conviction, shall be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars 17 (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned in the county jail for up to one (1) year, or both. 18 (b) For the purposes of this subsection (2), "air 19 operations area" means a portion of an airport designed and used 20 21 for landing, taking off, or surface maneuvering of airplanes;

- 22 <u>"sterile area" means an area to which access is controlled by the</u>
- 23 <u>inspection of persons and property in accordance with an approved</u>
- 24 <u>security program.</u>
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-17-87, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROVIDE ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR TRESPASS AS APPLIED TO AIRPORTS;
- 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
