Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 97-33-52, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 97-33-52. (1) A bingo game may be conducted only: 9 (a) When held for the benefit of a charitable 10 11 organization that (i) is licensed pursuant to Section 97-33-55 or 12 Section 97-33-59; (ii) is domiciled in the State of Mississippi; 13 and 14 (b) When the game is held by active members of such 15 organization. (2) Except as may be otherwise provided in Sections 97-33-51 16 through 97-33-203, or by rule or regulation of the commission, all 17 18 net proceeds derived from a bingo game authorized by this section shall be expended only for the purposes for which the organization 19 is created, and no net proceeds derived from a bingo game 20 authorized by this section shall be distributed to a charity 21 22 outside of the State of Mississippi without the approval of the 23 Mississippi Gaming Commission.

(3) None of the proceeds of a bingo game authorized to be held under this section shall be used to purchase, construct or improve a building, hall or other facility solely for the purpose of conducting or operating a bingo game.

(4) Every organization which conducts bingo games shall
report to the Mississippi Gaming Commission at such time, in such
manner and on such forms as the commission prescribes. All
records and reports so filed shall be public records and shall be
available for inspection in accordance with the Mississippi Public
Records Act of 1983.

34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after its passage.
