32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 45 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 46 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 47 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 48 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 49 50 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until

52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

53 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 54 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

59 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 61 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 62 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 64 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 65 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 and after July 1, 2001.
