20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

44 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 45 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 46 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 47 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 48 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 49 50 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 51 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall

52 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 53 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 54 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 55 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 56 57 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 58 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 59 60 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

80 SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 81 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

82 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 83 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 84 intended mission of this agency. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 107 Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 108 109 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 110 Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 111 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a

112 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than 113 114 One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars 115 (\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database. 116 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 117 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 118 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 119 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 120 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 121 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 122 and after July 1, 2001. 123
