- 184 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven
- 185 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the
- 186 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs only and not for educational
- 187 purposes.
- 188 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand
- 189 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Osteoporosis Program.
- 190 SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 191 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 192 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 193 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 194 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 195 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
