171 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 172 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 173 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 174 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 175 176 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 177 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 178 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 179 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 180 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 181 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 182 183 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 184 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 185 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 186 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 187 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 188 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 189

190 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer 191 192 between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 193 positions not to exceed five percent (5%) of the receiving office 194 in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 195 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, 196 Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 197 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 198 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of 199 Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month 200 prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the

201 intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 202 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and 203 that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 204 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 205 in the original appropriations made under this act.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

210 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 211 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 212 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 213 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 214 Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 215 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 216 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... .....\$ 4,000,001.00. 217

SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
