## 1 Amend by striking all after line 3 and inserting in lieu 2 thereof the following:

4 WHEREAS, it is only fitting that the law enforcement officers 5who have given their lives in the performance of their duties be 6remembered with the utmost respect; and

7 WHEREAS, the State Board of Law Enforcement Officer Standards 8 and Training, the Mississippi Department of Archives and History 9 and the Bureau of Capitol Facilities have put forth a concerted 10 effort to make an appropriate and meaningful Law Enforcement 11 Memorial a reality; and

12 WHEREAS, the monument design will be the result of a 13competition of appropriate designs submitted by architectural 14firms; and

15 WHEREAS, the location of the Law Enforcement Memorial should 16be selected in accordance with construction plans for the new 17Capitol Complex, which includes a proposed pedestrian mall between 18the Walter Sillers State Office Building and a newly constructed 19justice facility; and

20 WHEREAS, Mississippi's law enforcement officers are worthy of 21the highest praise:

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 23REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 24THEREIN, That we do hereby express the enthusiastic support of the 25Legislature for the location of the Law Enforcement Officers 26Memorial adjacent to the proposed pedestrian mall which is to be 27located between the Walter Sillers State Office Building and the 28newly constructed justice facility, with the exact location of the 29memorial to be west of the mall, between the mall and the new 30 justice building.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the pedestrian mall should 32remain open from George Street to High Street to provide an 33unobstructed view of the New Capitol Building from Congress 34Street, and that any other monuments should also be placed to the 35east or west of the mall.

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we express our appreciation to 37the State Board of Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training, 38the Mississippi Department of Archives and History and the Bureau 39of Capitol Facilities for their hard work and dedication to this 40important project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be 42forwarded to the State Board of Law Enforcement Officer Standards 43and Training, the Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department 44of Archives and History and the Executive Director of the 45Department of Finance and Administration, and be made available to 46the Capitol Press Corps.
