**AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill NO. 2239**

**By Senator(s) Blackmon, Frazier, Harden, Horhn,  
Jackson, Johnson(38), Jordan, Simmons, Turner, Walls**

1           **AMEND** by striking the underlined language on lines 222  
2 through 239 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
3           (d) Policies and procedures to provide that after  
4 having reported three (3) or more incidents of disruptive behavior  
5 by a student in the same class to the principal, or his designee,  
6 a teacher may issue an order, subject to approval of the  
7 principal, to remove such student from the specific class. Prior  
8 to issuing any such order, the teacher shall have reported to the  
9 principal, or his designee, the name of the student, the class in  
10 which his disruptive behavior occurred, and a concise, but  
11 specific, description of the behavior. The student and his  
12 parents shall be informed of any such report and its contents and  
13 provided the opportunity to meet with the teacher and the  
14 principal, or his designee, to discuss the student's behavior.  
15 The principal, or his designee, shall meet with the student, the  
16 parent, school counselor, if any, and the teacher after receiving  
17 the second report of such disruptive behavior to discuss the  
18 student's behavior and the possible consequences if such behavior  
19 does not cease. After three (3) such reports of disruptive  
20 behavior, the teacher, subject to approval of the principal, may

1 order the student removed from the relevant class, and the student  
2 may be disciplined appropriately in accordance with the school  
3 board's student conduct regulations.

4       **FURTHER, amend on line 250 by inserting before the period the**  
5 **following:**  
6 , and policies and procedures delineating under what circumstances  
7 individuals who associate are considered a gang
