1	AMEND by inserting the following new SECTION 1 after line 9
2	and by renumbering all succeeding sections accordingly:
3	SECTION 1. (1) Recognizing teaching as a profession as well
4	as a vocation, it is the intent of the Legislature, by the passage
5	of House Bill No. 1, 2001 First Extraordinary Session, to clarify
6	the commitment of the House of Representatives and Senate of the
7	State of Mississippi to increase the salaries of public school
8	teachers during the 2001-2002 school year and in each of the next
9	four (4) succeeding years. It is further the intent of the
10	Legislature, by the passage of House Bill No. 1, 2001 First
11	Extraordinary Session, to demonstrate its long term commitment to
12	improving education in the State of Mississippi.
13	(2) The school board of each school district shall provide
14	notice of the legislative intent expressed in subsection (1) of
15	this section to each teacher and assistant teacher. The notice
16	must be in writing and attached to or provided with at least one
17	(1) salary payment to each teacher and assistant teacher before
18	the expiration of sixty (60) days after the passage of House Bill
19	No. 1, 2001 First Extraordinary Session.
