AMENDMENT No. 2 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1

1 **AMEND** by striking Section 1 in its entirety and inserting in
2 lieu thereof the following:

3 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-1037, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4 amended as follows:

5 23-15-1037. (1) The State of Mississippi is hereby divided
6 into four (4) congressional districts as follows:

7 **FIRST DISTRICT.** The First Congressional District shall be
8 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
9 Alcorn, Benton, Calhoun, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Clay, DeSoto,
10 Itawamba, Lafayette, Lee, Marshall, Monroe, Montgomery, Pontotoc,
11 Prentiss, Tate, Tippah, Tishomingo, Union, Webster, Winston and
12 Yalobusha; in Attala County the precincts of Williamsville,
13 McCool, Liberty Chapel, Berea, Carmack, Hesterville, Possumneck,
14 North Central, Northwest, Aponaug, Thompson, Zama, Providence,
15 East and Ethel; in Carroll County the precincts of Calvary,
16 Jefferson Sub-A, North Carrollton Sub-A, North Carrollton Sub-B,
17 Rays Shop Sub-A, Jefferson Sub-B, Carrollton, Rays Shop Sub-B and
18 West Carroll; in Grenada County the precincts of Grenada Box 1,
19 Elliott, Sweethome, Gore Springs, Futheyville, Providence, Mt.
20 Nebo, Pleasant Grove, Geeslin, Hardy and Pea Ridge; in Lowndes
21 County the precincts of Caledonia, Steens A, Steens B, Caldwell,
22 Co-op A, Steens C, Fairview, Sale, Co-op B, Lee High, Brandon A,
23 Brandon B, Air Base A, Air Base B, Air Base C, Air Base D,

24 Trinity, Rural Hill A, New Hope A, New Hope B, Rural Hill B, Union
25 Academy A and Franklin A; and in Panola County the precincts of
26 East Sardis, Cold Springs, North Asa, Tocowa, Pope, Courtland,
27 Batesville 3, Coles Point, North Springport, South Springport,
28 Eureka, East Batesville 4, West Batesville 4, Fern Hill, North
29 Batesville A and East Batesville 5.

30 **SECOND DISTRICT.** The Second Congressional District shall be
31 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
32 Bolivar, Claiborne, Coahoma, Copiah, Holmes, Humphreys, Issaquena,
33 Jefferson, Leflore, Quitman, Sharkey, Sunflower, Tallahatchie,
34 Tunica, Warren, Washington and Yazoo; that portion of Attala
35 County not included in the First Congressional District; that
36 portion of Carroll County not included in the First Congressional
37 District; that portion of Grenada County not included in the First
38 Congressional District; in Hinds County the precincts of 2, 4, 5,
39 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23,
40 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41,
41 42, 43, 45, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62,
42 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 79, 80, 81, 82,

51 Smith School, Magnolia Heights, Flora, Virililia, Canton Precinct
52 5, New Industrial Park, Canton Precinct 4 and Bible Church; and
53 that portion of Panola County not included in the First
54 Congressional District.

55 **THIRD DISTRICT.** The Third Congressional District shall be
56 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
57 Adams, Amite, Franklin, Jasper, Jefferson Davis, Kemper,
58 Lauderdale, Lawrence, Leake, Lincoln, Neshoba, Newton, Noxubee,

59 Oktibbeha, Pike, Rankin, Scott, Simpson, Smith, Walthall and
60 Wilkinson; in Clarke County the precincts of South Quitman,
61 Harmony Beat 1, Nancy, Pachuta, Hale, Beaver Dam, Enterprise,
62 Harmony Beat 3 and Souinlovie; in Covington County the precincts
63 of Collins, Mt. Olive, Rock Hill, Dry Creek, Station Creek, Yawn,
64 Okahay and Gilmer; that portion of Hinds County not included in
65 the Second Congressional District; in Jones County the precincts
66 of Gitano, Hebron, Matthews and Soso; that portion of Lowndes
67 County not included in the First Congressional District; and that
68 portion of Madison County not included in the Second Congressional
69 District.

70 **FOURTH DISTRICT.** The Fourth Congressional District shall be
71 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
72 Forrest, George, Greene, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Lamar,
73 Marion, Pearl River, Perry, Stone and Wayne; that portion of
74 Clarke County not included in the Third Congressional District;
75 that portion of Covington County not included in the Third
76 Congressional District; and that portion of Jones County not
77 included in the Third Congressional District.

79 (2) The boundaries of the congressional districts described
80 in subsection (1) of this section shall be the boundaries of the
81 counties along such congressional district boundaries as the
82 boundaries of such counties existed on October 1, 2001, and the
83 precinct boundaries along such congressional district boundaries
84 as such precinct boundaries are contained in Census 2000
85 redistricting maps (Public Law 94-171) TIGER line file.
