- 56 the precincts of South Central, Northeast, Carmack, Hesterville,
- 57 <u>Possumneck, North Central, Northwest, Aponaug, McAdams, Newport,</u>
- 58 Sallis and Southwest; in Grenada County the precincts of Grenada
- 59 Box 1, Tie Plant, Elliott, Sweethome, Grenada Box 2, Gore Springs,

- 60 Futheyville, Providence, Grenada Box 3, Kirkman, Pleasant Grove,
- 61 Grenada Box 4, Geeslin, Grenada Box 5 and Holcomb; in Leake County
- 62 the precincts of North Carthage, Conway, West Carthage, Wiggins,
- 63 Thomastown and Ofahoma; in Madison County the precincts of Ratliff
- 64 Ferry, Canton Precinct 2, Canton Precinct 3, Canton Precinct 7,
- 65 Ridgeland 3, Ridgeland 4, Lorman-Cavalier, Ridgeland 1, Tougaloo,
- 66 <u>Smith School, Magnolia Heights, Flora, Virlilia, Canton Precinct</u>
- 67 <u>5, Liberty, New Industrial Park, Madison County Baptist Family</u>
- 68 Life Center, Cameron, Couparle, Camden, Sharon, Canton Precinct 1,
- 69 <u>Canton Precinct 4, Luther Branson School and Bible Church; in</u>
- 70 Montgomery County the precincts of Mt. Pisgah, North Winona, Duck
- 71 <u>Hill, West Winona, Alva, East Winona, Lodi, Kilmichael, Southeast</u>

- 82 **FOURTH DISTRICT.** The Fourth Congressional District shall be
- 83 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
- 84 Alcorn, Benton, Calhoun, Chickasaw, Choctaw, DeSoto, Itawamba,
- 85 <u>LaFayette, Lee, Marshall, Pontotoc, Prentiss, Tippah, Tishomingo,</u>
- 86 Union and Webster; that portion of Attala County not included in
- 87 the Third Congressional District; that portion of Grenada County
- 88 not included in the Third Congressional District; that portion of
- 89 <u>Leake County not included in the Third Congressional District;</u>
- 90 that portion of Madison County not included in the Third
- 91 <u>Congressional District; that portion of Monroe County not included</u>
- 92 <u>in the Second Congressional District; that portion of Montgomery</u>
- 93 <u>County not included in the Third Congressional District; that</u>
- 94 portion of Neshoba County not included in the Second Congressional

- 95 <u>District;</u> that portion of Newton County not included in the Second
- 96 <u>Congressional District; that portion of Panola County not included</u>
- 97 <u>in the Third Congressional District; that portion of Rankin County</u>
- 98 <u>not included in the Second Congressional District; that portion of</u>
- 99 <u>Scott County not included in the Second Congressional District;</u>
- 100 that portion of Tate County not included in the Third
- 101 <u>Congressional District; that portion of Winston County not</u>
- 102 included in the Second Congressional District; and that portion of
- 103 Yalobusha County not included in the Third Congressional District.

- 105 (2) The boundaries of the congressional districts described
- 106 in subsection (1) of this section shall be the boundaries of the
- 107 counties <u>along such congressional district boundaries as the</u>
- 108 boundaries of such counties existed on October 1, 2001, and the
- 109 precinct boundaries along such congressional district boundaries
- 110 <u>as such precinct boundaries are contained in Census 2000</u>
- 111 redistricting maps (Public Law 94-171) TIGER line file.
- 112 **SECTION 2.** The Chairman of the Standing Joint Congressional
- 113 Redistricting Committee, with the assistance of counsel employed
- 114 by the Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee, shall
- 115 submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor or
- 116 approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, either to the
- 117 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 118 District Court of the District of Columbia, or both, in accordance
- 119 with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended
- 120 and extended.
- 121 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 122 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 123 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
