Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 15 Zama, Providence, East and Ethel; in Hinds County Precincts 8, 9,
- 16 14, 15, 17, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 44, 45, 46 and 78; in Leake County
- 17 the precincts of Edinburg, East Carthage, Sunrise, Renfroe, South
- 18 Carthage, Good Hope, Lena, Freeny, Ebenezer, Walnut Grove, Salem
- 19 <u>and Madden; in Lowndes County the precincts of Caledonia, Steens</u>
- 20 A, Co-op A, Steens C and Lee High; in Madison County the precincts
- 21 of Trace Harbor, Main Harbor, Victory Baptist Church, Madison 1,
- 22 <u>Madison 2, Madison 3, Ridgeland 3, Ridgeland 4, Ridgeland First</u>
- 23 Methodist Church, Gluckstadt, Ridgeland 1, Ridgeland Tennis

- 24 Center, Highland Colony Baptist Church and Whispering Lake; in
- 25 Marshall County the precincts of Early Grove, Hudsonville,
- 26 Slayden, Mt. Pleasant, North Cayce, Byhalia, Cayce, Barton,
- 27 Warsaw, Potts Camp, Cornersville, Bethlehem and Waterford; in
- 28 Monroe County the precincts of Oak Hill, Smithville, Williams,
- 29 Parham, Hatley, Brooks, Amory 1, Bigbee 1, Boyds, Pickles,
- 30 Greenwood Springs, Quincy, Becker, Amory 2, Gattman, Bartahatchie,
- 31 Grubb Springs, Hamilton, Lackey, Athens, Darracott and Strong; in
- 32 Scott County the precincts of Homewood, East-West Morton,
- 33 Northwest Forest, Pulaski, Springfield, Cooperville, Clifton,
- 34 Beach, North Morton, Liberty and Ludlow; and in Yalobusha County
- 35 the precincts of North, Sylva Rena and Northwest.
- 36 **SECOND DISTRICT.** The Second Congressional District shall be
- 37 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
- 38 Bolivar, Carroll, Claiborne, Coahoma, Grenada, Holmes, Humphreys,
- 39 <u>Issaquena, Jefferson, Leflore, Montgomery, Panola, Quitman,</u>
- 40 Sharkey, Sunflower, Tallahatchie, Tate, Tunica, Warren,
- 41 <u>Washington, Yazoo; that portion of Attala County not included in</u>
- 42 the First Congressional District; in Hinds County Precincts 1, 2,
- 43 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26,
- 44 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 47, 50, 51, 52,
- 45 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 66, 67, 68, 69,
- 46 <u>70, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87 and 88, and the precincts</u>

- 55 THIRD DISTRICT. The Third Congressional District shall be
- 56 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
- 57 Adams, Amite, Chickasaw, Clay, Copiah, Covington, Franklin,
- 58 Jasper, Jefferson Davis, Kemper, Lawrence, Lincoln, Marion,

- 59 Neshoba, Newton, Noxubee, Oktibbeha, Pike, Simpson, Smith,
- 60 Walthall, Wilkinson, Winston; that portion of Hinds County not
- 61 <u>included</u> in the First Congressional District or the Second
- 62 <u>Congressional District; in Jones County the precincts of Lamar</u>
- 63 School, Bruce, Centerville, Laurel Courthouse, Pleasant Ridge,
- 64 <u>Cameron Center, Anthonys Florist, Blackwell, County Barn,</u>
- 65 <u>Ellisville Court House, Moselle, Pinegrove, Rainey, Sandhill,</u>
- 66 Shelton, South Jones, Union, Cooks Avenue Community Center,
- 67 <u>National Guard Armory, Nora Davis School, Roosevelt, Oak Park</u>
- 68 School, Pendorf, Maple Street YWCA, Old Health Department and
- 69 Currie; in Lauderdale County Precincts of 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11,
- 70 12, 14 and 15, and the precincts of Sageville and Meehan; that
- 71 portion of Lowndes County not included in the First Congressional
- 72 <u>District; that portion of Monroe County not included in the First</u>
- 73 <u>Congressional District; and that portion of Scott County not</u>
- 74 <u>included in the First Congressional District.</u>
- 75 **FOURTH DISTRICT.** The Fourth Congressional District shall be
- 76 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:
- 77 Clarke, Forrest, George, Greene, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson,
- 78 Lamar, Pearl River, Perry, Stone, Wayne; that portion of Jones
- 79 <u>County not included in the Third Congressional District; and that</u>
- 80 portion of Lauderdale County not included in the Third
- 81 <u>Congressional District.</u>

- 83 (2) The boundaries of the congressional districts described
- 84 in subsection (1) of this section shall be the boundaries of the
- 85 counties along such congressional district boundaries as the
- 86 boundaries of such counties existed on October 1, 2001, and the
- 87 precinct boundaries along such congressional district boundaries
- 88 <u>as such precinct boundaries are contained in Census 2000</u>
- 89 redistricting maps (Public Law 94-171) TIGER line file.
- 90 **SECTION 2.** The Chairman of the Standing Joint Congressional
- 91 Redistricting Committee, with the assistance of counsel employed
- 92 by the Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee, shall
- 93 submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor or

- 94 approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, either to the
- 95 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 96 District Court of the District of Columbia, or both, in accordance
- 97 with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended
- 98 and extended.
- 99 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 100 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 101 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
