**SUBSTITUTE 1 FOR AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill NO. 2001**

Robertson, Ross, Scoper, White(29)**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting  
in lieu thereof the following:**

5       **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-1037, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
6 amended as follows:

7       23-15-1037. (1) The State of Mississippi is hereby divided  
8 into four (4) congressional districts as follows:

9       **FIRST DISTRICT.** The First Congressional District shall be  
10 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:  
11 Alcorn, Benton, Calhoun, Carroll, Chickasaw, Clay, DeSoto,  
12 Grenada, Itawamba, Lafayette, Lee, Lowndes, Marshall, Monroe,  
13 Montgomery, Panola, Pontotoc, Prentiss, Tate, Tippah, Tishomingo,  
14 Union, Webster, Yalobusha; and in Lowndes County the precincts of  
15 Air Base A, Air Base B, Air Base C, Air Base D, Artesia, Brandon  
16 A, Brandon B, Caldwell, Caledonia, Coleman, Co-op A, Co-op B,  
17 Fairgrounds A, Fairgrounds C, Fairview, Franklin A, Franklin B,  
18 Hunt A, Hunt B, Hunt C, Lee High, Mayhew, Mitchell, Plum Grove C,  
19 Rural Hill B, Sale, Steens A, Steens B, Steens C, Stokes Beard,  
20 Trinity, Union Academy A, Union Academy B, University A,  
21 University B and West Lowndes.

22       **SECOND DISTRICT.** The Second Congressional District shall be  
23 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:

24 Adams, Bolivar, Claiborne, Coahoma, Copiah, Franklin, Hinds,  
25 Holmes, Humphreys, Issaquena, Jefferson, Leflore, Quitman,  
26 Sharkey, Sunflower, Tallahatchie, Tunica, Warren, Washington,  
27 Wilkinson and Yazoo.

28       **THIRD DISTRICT.** The Third Congressional District shall be  
29 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:  
30 Attala, Choctaw, Clarke, Covington, Jasper, Jefferson Davis,  
31 Jones, Kemper, Lauderdale, Lawrence, Leake, Lowndes, Madison,  
32 Neshoba, Newton, Noxubee, Oktibbeha, Rankin, Scott, Simpson,  
33 Smith, Wayne, Winston; and that portion of Lowndes County not  
34 included in the First Congressional District.

35       **FOURTH DISTRICT.** The Fourth Congressional District shall be  
36 composed of the following counties and portions of counties:  
37 Amite, Forrest, George, Greene, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Lamar,  
38 Lincoln, Marion, Pearl River, Perry, Pike, Stone and Walthall.

40       (2) The boundaries of the congressional districts described  
41 in subsection (1) of this section shall be the boundaries of the  
42 counties along such congressional district boundaries as the  
43 boundaries of such counties existed on October 1, 2001, and the  
44 precinct boundaries along such congressional district boundaries  
45 as such precinct boundaries are contained in Census 2000  
46 redistricting maps (Public Law 94-171) TIGER line file.

47       **SECTION 2.** The Chairman of the Standing Joint Congressional  
48 Redistricting Committee, with the assistance of counsel employed  
49 by the Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee, shall  
50 submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor or  
51 approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, either to the  
52 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States  
53 District Court of the District of Columbia, or both, in accordance  
54 with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended  
55 and extended.

56       **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
57 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting  
58 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and  
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**
