- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) Each local school board shall adopt and
- 6 implement policies prohibiting any teacher, counselor or other
- 7 school personnel from recommending the use of psychiatric drugs
- 8 for any child. However, this section does not prohibit: (a)
- 9 school medical staff from recommending that a child be evaluated
- 10 by an appropriate medical practitioner; or (b) school personnel
- 11 from consulting, with the consent of a child's parent or guardian,
- 12 with a medical practitioner concerning the child.
- 13 (2) The refusal of a parent or other person having control
- 14 of a child to administer or consent to the administration of any
- 15 psychiatric drug to that child does not, in and of itself,
- 16 constitute grounds for the Department of Human Services to take
- 17 the child into custody or for any court of competent jurisdiction
- 18 to order that the child be taken into custody by the department
- 19 unless the refusal causes the child to be neglected or abused, as
- 20 defined in Section 43-21-105.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2002.
