- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 6 chapter to the contrary, an injured worker is not eligible to
- 7 receive workers' compensation benefits or medical expenses for
- 8 periods of time during which the worker is incarcerated for the
- 9 commission of a crime unless the injured worker had been "found"
- 10 to have a permanent and total loss of wage-earning capacity which
- 11 was attributable to the work-related injury.
- 12 (2) As used in this section, an individual is not
- 13 "incarcerated" if the individual is on parole or work release
- 14 status.
- 15 (3) If upon appeal such conviction is overturned, the
- 16 benefits suspended during the period of incarceration shall be
- 17 reinstated.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2002.
