HOUSE BILL NO. 110

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI FLAG AND THE UNITED STATES FLAG TO BE
- 3 DISPLAYED FROM SUNRISE TO SUNSET FROM ALL PUBLIC BUILDINGS IN THIS 4 STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 3-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 3-3-15. The state flag and the flag of the United States of
- 9 America shall be displayed from all public buildings in this state
- 10 from sunrise to sunset; however, such flags may be displayed from
- 11 all public buildings twenty-four (24) hours a day if properly
- 12 illuminated. <u>Such flags shall</u> not be displayed when the weather
- is inclement, except when * * * all-weather flags are displayed.
- 14 The state flag shall receive all of the respect and ceremonious
- 15 etiquette given the American flag. * * * However, nothing in this
- 16 section shall be construed so as to affect the precedence given to
- 17 the flag of the United States of America.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2002.
