## HOUSE BILL NO. 136

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COMPREHENSIVE COURSE IN MISSISSIPPI
HISTORY TO BE TAUGHT TO ALL NINTH GRADE STUDENTS IN THE PUBLIC
SCHOOLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. In addition to the curriculum otherwise required

by law or the State Board of Education to be taught in the public 6 schools of this state, a comprehensive course in Mississippi 7 8 History is required for all ninth grade students. The objective of the Mississippi History course must be to provide students with 9 an examination of the history of the State of Mississippi from the 10 age of discovery and colonization to the present with particular 11 emphasis on the significant political, social, economic and 12 13 cultural issues of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries which have impacted the diverse ethnic and racial populations of the 14 15 state.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 17 and after July 1, 2002.
