HOUSE BILL NO. 157

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT TAKING MONEY FROM AN ELDERLY ADULT 1
- THROUGH UNDUE INFLUENCE, MISREPRESENTATION, FALSE PRETENSES OR 2
- 3 DECEPTION IS A FELONY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to take 5
- money from an elderly adult through undue influence, 6
- misrepresentation, false pretenses or deception. 7
- 8 (2) Any person who takes One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000,00) or
- more from an elderly adult through undue influence, 9
- misrepresentation, false pretenses or deception shall be guilty of 10
- a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine 11
- not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or by imprisonment 12
- 13 not to exceed ten (10) years in the State Penitentiary, or by both
- such fine and imprisonment. 14
- For purposes of this act, "elderly adult" means any 15
- adult over sixty (60) years of age. 16
- (4) Nothing contained in this section shall prevent 17

- 18 proceedings against a person under any statute of this state or
- municipal ordinance defining any act as a crime, misdemeanor or 19
- 20 felony.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after its passage.
