HOUSE BILL NO. 163

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO AUTHORIZE THE 1 COMMISSIONER OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO 2 3 ESTABLISH A MANDATORY DRUG AND ALCOHOL REHABILITATION PROGRAM FOR ALL OFFENDERS SENTENCED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE MISSISSIPPI 4 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS WHO HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF A DRUG OR 5 ALCOHOL RELATED CRIME OR WHO HAVE COMMITTED A CRIME BECAUSE OF 6 7 DRUG OR ALCOHOL ADDICTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 The Mississippi Department of Corrections is 9 SECTION 1. 10 authorized to establish a mandatory drug and alcohol rehabilitation program for all offenders convicted on drug or 11 alcohol related charges and shall have the power and duty to adopt 12 rules not inconsistent with law as it may deem proper and 13 14 necessary with respect to the establishment, administration and 15 operation of the program. SECTION 2. Any offender sentenced to the custody of the 16 Mississippi Department of Corrections who has been convicted of a 17 drug or alcohol related crime or who has committed a crime because 18 of drug or alcohol addiction shall undergo a mandatory drug and 19 alcohol rehabilitation program as established by the department. 20

21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after July 1, 2002.
