HOUSE BILL NO. 239

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT INSURANCE COMPANIES FROM SETTLING
INSURANCE CLAIMS UNTIL THE INSURED PARTY APPROVES AND SIGNS THE
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
<u>SECTION 1.</u> No insurance company doing business in this state
may settle any insurance claim until the insured party approves

7 and signs the settlement agreement.

8 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 9 and after July 1, 2002.
