## HOUSE BILL NO. 251

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- 2 OTHERWISE DISSEMINATES INFORMATION OR MATERIAL THAT CONTAINS THE
- 3 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL, THE AGENCY SHALL TAKE 4 SUCH STEPS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY TO PREVENT THE
- 5 INADVERTENT DISCLOSURE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER
- 6 TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC OR TO PERSONS OTHER THAN THOSE PERSONS
- 7 HAVING A LEGITIMATE AND LAWFUL NEED TO KNOW THE INDIVIDUAL'S
- 8 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES; AND FOR
- 9 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** When any state agency mails, delivers,
- 12 circulates, publishes, distributes, transmits, or otherwise
- 13 disseminates, in any form or manner, information or material that
- 14 contains the social security number of an individual, the agency
- 15 shall take such steps as may be reasonably necessary to prevent
- 16 the inadvertent disclosure of the individual's social security
- 17 number to members of the general public or to persons other than
- 18 those persons who, in the performance of their duties and
- 19 responsibilities, have a lawful and legitimate need to know the
- 20 individual's social security number.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2002.
