HOUSE BILL NO. (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN A STATE AGENCY MAILS, DELIVERS OR OTHERWISE DISSEMINATES INFORMATION OR MATERIAL THAT CONTAINS THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL, THE AGENCY SHALL TAKE SUCH STEPS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY TO PREVENT THE 3 INADVERTENT DISCLOSURE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC OR TO PERSONS OTHER THAN THOSE PERSONS 6 7 HAVING A LEGITIMATE AND LAWFUL NEED TO KNOW THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES; AND FOR 8 9 RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10
- 11 SECTION 1. When any state agency mails, delivers,
- circulates, publishes, distributes, transmits, or otherwise 12
- disseminates, in any form or manner, information or material that 13
- contains the social security number of an individual, the agency 14
- 15 shall take such steps as may be reasonably necessary to prevent
- 16 the inadvertent disclosure of the individual's social security
- number to members of the general public or to persons other than 17
- those persons who, in the performance of their duties and 18
- responsibilities, have a lawful and legitimate need to know the 19
- individual's social security number. State agencies shall be in 20
- 21 compliance with this act on or before July 1, 2003.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22
- and after July 1, 2002. 23
