- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 9 63-3-519. It is unlawful for any person or peace officer or
- law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway Safety 10
- Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of radar 11
- speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or highway 12
- of this state. However, such equipment may be used: 13
- 14 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a
- municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more 15
- upon the public streets of the municipality, excluding federally 16
- designated highways or highways on the state designated highway 17
- system; and 18
- 19 By any college or university campus police force
- within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand 20
- (2,000) students are enrolled. 21

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
- and after July 1, 2002. 24
