HOUSE BILL NO. 322

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION WITHIN A PUBLIC PLACE OF ANY SOUND SYSTEM OR OTHER DEVICE IN A MANNER THAT PRODUCES SUCH LOUD OR UNUSUAL NOISE OR ABUSIVE, PROFANE, VULGAR OR INDECENT LANGUAGE SO AS TO DISTURB THE PEACE OF OTHERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 7 operate in, upon or within the right-of-way of any public street,
- 8 road or highway or in or upon any other public place or structure
- 9 any radio, recorder, high fidelity or other mechanical or
- 10 electronic sound system or device in a manner that produces such
- 11 loud or unusual noise or such abusive, profane, vulgar or indecent
- 12 language so as to disturb the peace of others lawfully present or
- 13 occupying such place or structure.
- 14 (2) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (1)
- 15 of this section, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of
- 16 not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), by imprisonment in
- 17 the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both
- 18 such fine and imprisonment.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2002.
