HOUSE BILL NO. 324

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-35-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE THE COMPENSATION THAT THE COURT MAY AUTHORIZE A
- 3 GARNISHEE TO BE PAID FOR ATTENDANCE AT GARNISHMENT PROCEEDING; AND
- 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11-35-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 11-35-61. The garnishee shall be allowed for his attendance,
- 9 out of the debts or effects in his possession, or against the
- 10 plaintiff in attachment, judgment, or decree in case there be no
- 11 debts or effects in his possession, provided he shall put in his
- 12 answer within the time prescribed by law, the pay and mileage of a
- 13 juror, and, in exceptional cases rendering it proper, the court
- 14 <u>shall</u> allow the garnishee reasonable compensation additional to
- 15 the foregoing and to be obtained in the same way which shall be
- 16 not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Seventy-five
- 17 Dollars (\$75.00).
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2002.
