HOUSE BILL NO. 339

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS IN COMMEMORATION OF LIONS OF MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE FEES COLLECTED FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS 3 4 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AMONG LIONS SIGHT FOUNDATION OF MISSISSIPPI, 5

- INCORPORATED, THE MISSISSIPPI FIRE FIGHTER'S MEMORIAL BURN CENTER 6
- 7 FUND AND THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 9
- 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972: 10
- 27-19-56.32. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 11
- member of Lions of Mississippi, upon payment of the road and 12
- bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 13
- prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 14
- 15 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 16
- section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 17
- vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a member 18
- of Lions of Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so issued 19
- shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, 20
- with the advice of Lions of Mississippi, may prescribe and shall 21
- consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 22
- 23 to distinguish each license tag.
- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 24
- by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 25
- prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 26
- additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 27
- 28 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
- shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission within seven (7) 29

- 30 days of the date the application is made. The portion of the
- 31 additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited
- 32 into the county general fund.
- 33 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 34 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 35 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 36 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 37 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 38 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 39 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 40 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 41 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 42 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 43 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 44 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 45 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
- 46 collector.
- 47 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 48 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 49 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 50 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
- 51 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
- 52 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:
- 53 (a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee
- 54 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 55 section shall be distributed to Lions Sight Foundation of
- 56 Mississippi, Inc.
- 57 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- 58 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 59 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
- 60 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 61 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
- 62 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this

- 63 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 64 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 65 reconstruction of highways.
- 66 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 67 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 68 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 69 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 70 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 71 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 72 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 73 tag.
- 74 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 75 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 76 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 77 Section 27-19-37.
- 78 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after July 1, 2002.
