HOUSE BILL NO. 346

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-13-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO FLY THE UNITED STATES FLAG AT HALF-STAFF WHENEVER A PRESIDENTIAL ORDER OR INSTRUCTIONS OR FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES THE FLAG TO BE LOWERED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-13-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-13-5. (1) The flag of the State of Mississippi and the
- 9 flag of the United States shall be displayed in close proximity to
- 10 the school building at all times during the hours of daylight when
- 11 the school is in session when the weather will permit without
- 12 damage to the flag. It shall be the duty of the board of trustees
- 13 of the school district to provide for the flags and their display.
- 14 (2) Whenever the flag of the United States is to be flown at
- 15 half-staff by order or instructions of the President or pursuant
- 16 to federal law, all public schools shall lower the United States
- 17 flag in accordance with the executive order or instructions or
- 18 federal law. The school shall announce the reason that the flag
- 19 is being flown at half-staff to all students in assembly or by
- 20 <u>teachers in the various classrooms or by prominently displaying</u>
- 21 written notice throughout the school stating the reason that the
- 22 <u>flag has been lowered.</u>
- 23 (3) In all public schools there shall be given a course of
- 24 study concerning the flag of the United States and the flag of the
- 25 State of Mississippi. The course of study shall include the
- 26 history of each flag and what they represent and the proper
- 27 respect therefor. There <u>also</u> shall * * * be taught in the public

- 28 schools the duties and obligations of citizenship, patriotism,
- 29 Americanism and respect for and obedience to law.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after July 1, 2002.
