HOUSE BILL NO. 362

AN ACT TO CREATE A DISTINCTIVE "CHOOSE LIFE" MOTOR VEHICLE 1 LICENSE TAG; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE FEE CHARGED FOR SUCH 2 TAG SHALL BE DISBURSED TO THE CHOOSE LIFE ADVISORY COUNCIL; AND 3 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 6 SECTION 1. resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 7 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 8 9 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 10 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (4) of this 11 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 12 vehicle registered in his name, which shall be produced in such 13 color and design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of 14 the Choose Life Advisory Council, may prescribe. The words 15 "Choose Life" shall be centered at the bottom of the license tag. 16 The State Tax Commission shall prescribe such letters or numbers, 17 or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 18

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 19 (2) 20 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 21 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 22 Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 23 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 24 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee 25 26 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county 27 general fund.

No. 362 02/HR40/R350 PAGE 1 (JWB\BD) (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 28 29 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 30 of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each distinctive license tag 31 32 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 33 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 34 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 35 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 36 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 37 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 38 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 39 40 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 41

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected
under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute
such collections as follows:

47 (a) Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of each additional fee
48 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
49 section shall be disbursed to the Choose Life Advisory Council.

50 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 51 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 52 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn 53 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

54 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee

56 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
57 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed asrequired by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under

H. B. No. 362 02/HR40/R350 PAGE 2 (JWB\BD) this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) month and year license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the license tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 67 (6)tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 68 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 69 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 70 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 71 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 72 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 73 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 74 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 75 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 76

77 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from78 and after July 1, 2002.
