HOUSE BILL NO. 391

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REMOVE THE ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED TO BE PAID BY VOLUNTEER 3 FIREFIGHTERS IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE FIREFIGHTER 4 LICENSE TAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

27-19-56.1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a fire 8 9 fighter, including a career fire fighter, a volunteer fire fighter or an industrial fire fighter, employed by or in the service of 10 any municipality, county, fire district, state agency or industry 11 in the state who is a resident of this state, or who is a retired 12 fire fighter who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the 13 road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration 14 fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, 15 pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon 16 payment of any additional fee required under subsection (3) of 17 this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each 18 motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 19 fire fighter or retired fire fighter. The distinctive license 20 tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be agreed 21 upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Fire Fighters 22 Association and the State Tax Commission, shall consist of such 23 letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish 24 each license tag and may, in the discretion of the State Tax 25 26 Commission, display the county name.

27 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
28 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
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prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such 29 30 distinctive license tags (a) shall present to the issuing official 31 proof of their employment or service as a fire fighter by presentation of the applicant's official fire fighter 32 33 identification card or a signed and notarized affidavit from the governing authority or chief executive officer of the 34 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry by or for 35 whom the applicant is employed or serves as a fire fighter; or (b) 36 shall present proof that they are a retired fire fighter by 37 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the 38 governing authority or chief executive officer of the 39 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry from whom 40 the fire fighter retired. The application and the additional fee 41 imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three percent 42 (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 43 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 44 prescribed by the commission. The portion of any additional fee 45 required to be imposed under subsection (3) of this section that 46 is retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 47 48 county general fund.

(3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 49 50 after July 1, 2002, any person, except a volunteer fire fighter, who applies for a distinctive license tag under this section shall 51 pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for 52 53 each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional 54 55 fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due 56 and payable at the time the original application is made for a 57 distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually 58 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains 59 60 the distinctive license tag. Volunteer fire fighters shall be exempt from the payment of an additional fee. If the owner does 61

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66 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, 67 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the 68 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of 69 70 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees 71 72 collected from the issuance of such distinctive license tags issued under this section to the State General Fund, and the 73 remainder of such additional fees collected shall be distributed 74 by the State Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created 75 in Section 7-9-70. 76

A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 77 (5)required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 78 79 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 80 81 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 82 83 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 84 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 85 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 86 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 87 Section 27-19-37, Mississippi Code of 1972. The fee for a 88 replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). 89 The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall 90 be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund 91 five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and 92 93 the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds

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94 from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under 95 this section.

(7) In lieu of the distinctive license tag authorized under 96 97 subsections (1) through (6) of this section, any person who 98 presents proof of his employment or service as a fire fighter in the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section, may be 99 100 issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor vehicle 101 registered in his name identifying such person as a fire fighter. The distinctive license tag decal shall be of such size, color and 102 design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the 103 104 Mississippi Fire Fighters Association and the State Tax 105 Commission; however, the State Tax Commission shall have final 106 approval of the size, color and design. The distinctive license 107 tag decals shall be prepared and sold at Two Dollars (\$2.00) each through the Mississippi Fire Fighters Training Academy; however, 108 volunteer fire fighters shall be exempt from the payment of such 109 fee. 110

111 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 112 and after July 1, 2002.
