HOUSE BILL NO. 442

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-23-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO AUTHORIZE COUNTIES WITH COUNTY COURTS TO HAVE ASSISTANT COUNTY 2 ATTORNEYS; TO REQUIRE ATTENDANCE IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS IN 3 JUSTICE COURT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-23-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 19-23-21. The county attorney of any county having a county 8 9 court may appoint an assistant county attorney from the judicial district in which the county attorney * * * resides, to serve as 10 assistant county attorney; the assistant county attorney shall 11 receive the same salary, mileage expense account and secretarial 12 assistance as provided by law for the county attorney and shall 13 have the same duties and powers as the county attorney, subject to 14 the direction of the county attorney, and shall attend justice 15 16 court and represent the state in all criminal cases filed with the justice courts. Each county attorney or his assistant shall 17 attend justice court in every criminal case filed in justice 18 19 court. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 20

21 and after its passage.
